School Priorities Success Criteria 2013/14

- **Reading**

Progress will show that there are at least two sub levels progress at the end of the year and no child will make less than 2 levels progress from KS1 to KS2.

More children will achieve Level 3 reading achieving parity between the percentage of outcomes of the Levels 5s and Level 3s in KS2 and KS1 respectively.

In Reception class a greater emphasis on Reading earlier in the year focussing on EAL children ensuring they are in line with the class at the end of the year.

- **French**

Teaching in KS1 and KS2 will be at least good. A programme of work will be developed to show clear progress from KS1 to KS2.

Teachers will be confident to deliver the lessons next year.

- **Computing**

Teaching will be at least good. Children will experience more programming and be confident to develop their own algorithms at the end of KS2.

- **Sport and PE**

Teaching will be at least good and the support offered to colleagues will have developed more confidence and knowledge.

- **Assessment**

SIT (Self Improvement Time) will give children a focus each week and result in a higher awareness of the expectations in English and a greater understanding how they are learning/progressing

Tracking will enable colleagues to focus more on impact and will be able to “tell the story” of their children using data and sources of data.

Moderation will ensure there is confidence amongst colleagues about prior assessments/attainment

External Priorities

Success Criteria

- The school is fulfilling the requirements and expectations of the DfE

- Training and materials will be sourced and children will be prepared for the summer assessments
- The office to meet the new standard
